General Rules & Regulations

1. Only 4-H and FFA members who reside in South Carolina will be able to participate in the shows. Non-members will be allowed to submit entries in the open art show classes only.

2. Purebred cattle must be registered with their National Breed Association. Registration Papers must be in the name of the exhibitor. Cattle not registered will be entered in the crossbred classes.

3. Exhibitors must have owned all animals at least 45 days prior to the date of the show.

4. Exhibitors must provide food and water for their animal exhibits and keep their animals and area clean and presentable at all times.

5. Animals will be released after the completion of each show. **There will be no removal of animals while the shows are in progress.** Any exhibitor removing animals without official release or before release time forfeits all prize monies or awards they have won.

6. No trailers will be allowed to park in front of the Exchange Building. All exhibitor vehicles and trailers should be parked behind the Exchange Building.

7. No bulls or bucks are allowed at the Laurens County 4-H Livestock Shows.

8. Show Superintendents will rule on all matters not covered by these or other department rules.

9. Any exhibitor using abusive or excessive force with their animal as determined by the on-site Show Superintendent(s) will be asked to leave the fairground and forfeit any premium money

10. **Entry forms and entry fees must be postmarked by Friday, August 10, 2018. Late entries will receive an additional \$15 late fee. NO entries will be accepted after August 17, 2018!** All requested information must be completed for an entry form to be considered official. **Entry fees are \$5 per class. Money Orders and/or checks are accepted and should be written to the Laurens County Cattlemen's Association.** Entries will be received until the entry deadline or until entries exceed the barn capacity. **Mail entries to: Laurens County Extension, 219 W. Laurens Street, Laurens, SC 29360.**

11. Exhibitors must show their own animal in the **showmanship** classes.

12. **NO STALLING AREA WILL BE PROVIDED. All animals should be safely tied to their trailers. Wash area will be provided. If you have question about our new set up, please feel free to call us at 864-984-2514.**

Health Requirements

1. It is strongly encouraged that all cattle should be vaccinated for respiratory disease (shipping fever), specifically IBR, PI3, BRSV, and Pasteurella not more than 6 months and not less that 2 weeks prior to the show.

2. All animals should be healthy and free of any signs of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases. The Show Superintendent and agents appointed by him/her do have the authority to dismiss any animal viewed as unhealthy from the premises.

Rules and Regulations

1. Animals will be received between 4-5 PM on Friday, August 24, 2018. All goats must be in place by 5 PM -- NO EXCEPTIONS! Scales will be closed 30 minutes prior to the start of the show.
2. The Meat Goat classes are open only to 4-H or FFA members registered in the 2018 SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Project.
3. Junior Meat Goat Show entry fees are \$5 per class. The entry fees and forms must be postmarked by Friday, August 10, 2018. Mail entries to: Laurens County Extension, 219 W. Laurens Street, Laurens, SC 29360
- 4. Exhibitors must furnish feed and water for their animals.**
5. Showmanship is open to SC Meat Goat participants. Exhibitors may show any goat in Showmanship that they have entered in Market Wethers (lottery), SC4ME Wethers (born & bred), or Market Doe classes.
6. Showmanship classes are based on participant's age as of January 1, 2018.
7. **Market Wethers (Lottery):** Only SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Project participants will be allowed to participate in Market Wether Classes with a wether that has a Project Lottery wether ear tag. No "open" wethers are allowed. There will be three class of Market Wethers (lottery), as determined by the wether weight on day of show.
8. **SC4ME (Born & Bred):** All SC4ME wethers must be tagged with an SC4ME tag and registered to the exhibitor through the SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Project. There will be three class of Market Wethers (born & bred), as determined by the wether weight on day of show.
9. **Market Does:** Market does must be born between September 1, 2017 and June 10, 2018. Market does must be tagged with a SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Project tag and be registered to the exhibitor. Only one doe per exhibitor per class will be allowed. Each exhibitor may weigh in up to 6 does. Exhibitors with more than one doe in a class will be

required to choose which doe he/she wants to show in that class.

10. Exhibitors must be able to control their animal(s) at all times during show. Parents are not allowed in the show ring to assist their child during judging. Parents entering the ring during judging to assist their own child will result in the exhibitor being disqualified.

11. Cloverbud exhibitors may request a senior exhibitor to accompany them in the Market Wethers, SC4ME Wethers, or Market Doe classes only. NO assistant will be allowed in Showmanship classes. The assistant is only allowed to step in and control the goat for the safety of the exhibitor(s) or the goat. Assistants are not allowed to lead, set-up or brace the goats.

Rules and Regulations

1. All entries shall be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Laurens County Youth Show.

2. Beef Cattle entry fees are \$5 per class. The entry fees and forms must be postmarked by Friday, August 10, 2018. Mail entries to: Laurens County Extension, 219 W. Laurens Street, Laurens, SC 29360

3. Beef cattle will be received between 12 – 1 PM on Saturday, August 25, 2018. All cattle must be in place by 1 PM -- NO EXCEPTIONS!

4. The Beef Show is open to the following breeds: British Breeds (Angus, Polled Hereford, Shorthorn), Continental Breeds (Simmental, Limousin, Charolais, Gelviah, Salers, Maine Anjou, etc.), and Zebu and Crossbreds (cross bred cattle and registered Zebu influenced breeds).

5. Showmanship Ages are determined as of 1/1/18.

6. Heifers and steers are eligible for showmanship classes.

7. Feeder Steers will comply with weight standards as outlined by the SC 4-H Feeder Steer Project. Steer weight range is 450 - 1000 lbs. Steers not within this weight range are not eligible for the Feeder Steer Show.

8. Feeder Steers will be weighed prior to the show. Classes will be determined based on this weight as calculated by the Beef Show Superintendent. The number of Steer Show Classes will be influenced by steer weights and the number of steers competing. A maximum of 3 classes can be conducted. The Beef Show Committee will rule on the number of classes.
