SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Project Virtual Showmanship Submission Guidelines

1. Show attire is not required but permissible. Exhibitors are required to wear appropriate clothing (long pants, boots, and a neat shirt).
2. Video recordings must only show one goat and exhibitor combination. While videoing, the sound must be on at all times.
3. Someone may assist the exhibitor by videoing the exhibitor. No one is allowed to coach or talk to the exhibitor while they are being videoed.
4. No video editing or splicing is allowed. If a video is suspected of being edited, the entry will be disqualified.
5. Video structure:
 - a. Introduce yourself (10 points)
 - i. Name
 - ii. Age
 - iii. County
 - b. Introduce your animal's fitting (40 points)
 - i. Profile- take a profile overview of each side of goat
 - ii. Feet - take a close up of all 4 hooves
 - iii. Head- take a close up of head and ears
 - iv. Body- walk in a full circle around the goat while filming
 - c. Showmanship skills (50 points)
 - i. Identify correctly 10 goats body parts
 - ii. Walk your goat in a circle. Stop 3 times at least 10 steps apart and set up your goat. Show views from the front, side, and back each time you stop and set up.
 - iii. Explain what you think the strongest aspect of your goat is, and why? Show a close up of the aspect of your goat.
 - iv. Explain what is something you would like to improve on your goat and why? Once again, show a close up of this aspect of your goat.
6. View uploading:
 - a. Upload your video to this 2020 Virtual Meat Goat Showmanship folder.
 - b. Change the name of your video to your first initial and last name (ex. Ashley McCarter = A. McCarter)
 - c. Once videos have been received by the project, exhibitors will receive a confirmation email.
